WiseGP shares a new vision for general practice...

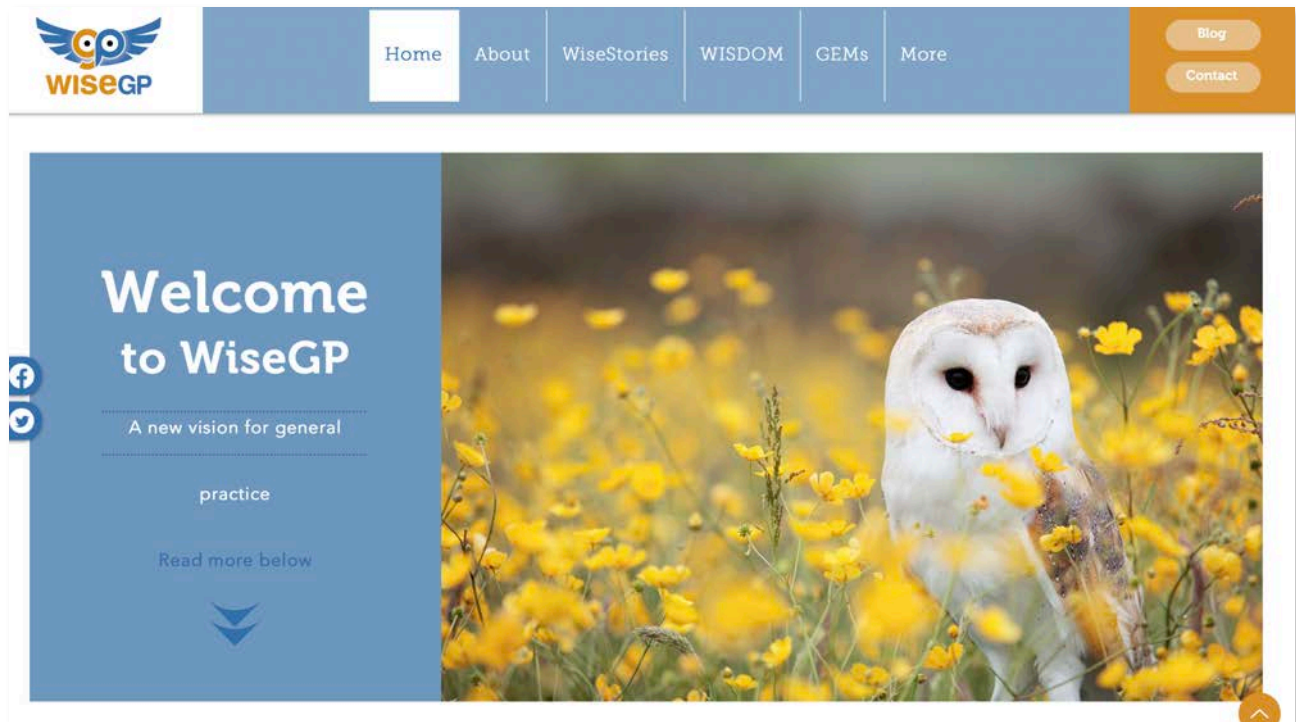


We all know that general practice needs to change. Indeed, many external voices have an opinion on how.

But from a packed room at RCGP conference in 2017 came the voice of frontline GPs determined to take back [professional control](#) of front-line patient care. [WiseGP](#) was born.

General practice delivers some of the most complex healthcare in the modern NHS. Our daily work is defined not by guidelines, or contracts, but by our ability to work beyond those boundaries to manage undifferentiated and complex needs. This is the distinct [knowledge work](#) of advanced generalist practice.





But these skills are not adequately understood, valued and supported in the way we run the NHS. We set up [WiseGP](#) to change that.

WiseGP is a partnership between the RCGP and the [Society for Academic Primary Care](#). 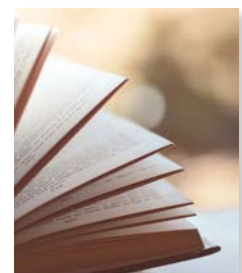
